Why Homes?

We believe that every person needs a home. A stable home leads to better health, employment, education, and community. Homes fulfill a basic human need and provide a foundation for life. Combined with LightHouse DC’s thoughtful approach, this focus on the home provides substantially better chances for enduring success in the transition away from homelessness.

LightHouse DC helps formerly homeless and low-income residents in our community transition to and sustain affordable housing. Using an innovative “community-based” model, LightHouse is the only nonprofit service in the DC Metro region that *moves* and *furnishes* homes in the community. In just 18 months of operations, LightHouse has moved and furnished 96 homes for 211 residents.

Solution

Critical Gap: LightHouse focuses on residents at the crossroads of homelessness and housing stability, where they have a “space” but not a real furnished home. These residents are on the threshold of greater long-term stability. We partner with existing nonprofits and government agencies, who have provided housing and other key services, but are stretched too thin (and also may not have the expertise) to cover moving and furnishing.

Community-based Model: LightHouse works directly in the community moving and furnishing residents’ homes. We effectively channel the generosity of grassroots volunteers, furniture donors, and local business. We collaborate with fellow nonprofits and government agencies to leverage available resources and eliminate duplicated efforts, thereby strengthening the critical areas which provide real results.

Cost Savings: LightHouse brings cutting-edge supply chain and logistics practices to bear in the context of a traditional community service organization. Through our community-based model, we have shown to reduce the average cost of moving and furnishing by up to **\$6,000 per household**. When compared to the community costs of inaction and the benefits assessment (health, permanence, & reintegration), the exceptional community returns are clear.
